School Management Board

The prestigious Saraswat Education Society(R) Mangalore, which runs 'Ganapathy English Medium School' and 'Ganapathi Pre University College' in Mangalore has established the Educational institution in the rural environment of Someshwar in 1946 and is running it efficiently. The school development work is being carried out under the guidance of Saraswat Education society's Secretary Mahesh L. Bondal and CEO as well as the correspondent of our school Mr. Prashant R. Rao.

School Staff

Including the Headmaster there are 9 permanent teachers, 2 permanent staff members and 1 Assistant teacher from the school management, A total of 12 people are working with great dedication.

Enrollment of students

At present a total of 71 Students are studying in class 8A and B, a total of 73 students in class 9th and B and a total of 73 students in class 10th A and B making a total of 217 students.

School Result.

In the 2021- 22 year SSLC exam 21 students passed with the distinction, 35 first class, 17 second class, three students passed in third class with the 88% result.

Sports and Cultural Achievements.

It is a matter of great pride that our students have won many prizes at Hobli level, taluk and district level in sports and cultural competitions from the local and educational department.

<u>Distribution of School Duties</u> With the aim of inculcating the flow of school duty, discipline, leadership responsibility in the children as per the school heritage, Pratap, Shivaji, Tagore and Subash divided into four houses under the leadership of the house teacher. Discipline, school cleanliness, wall magazine etc. are being carried out successfully.

Old Students Association.

In 1952, On the advice of Mr.Kalmadi Rama Rao, Mr. J.Krishna Bhatt established the school Alumni Association with the co-operation of Mr Amrita Someshwar. Presently the school Old Students Association is functioning very successfully under the chairmanship of Mr.Amrith Someshwar's son Mr.Jeevan Someshwar and under the leadership of Mr.Chandrashekar as the General Secretary.

Cycle Distribution.

25 Cycles were given to the deserving students of our school with the co-operation of 'Mr.Muralidhar Shenoy' who is the head of the sales department of Canara Robeco mutual fund, Mangalore.

Distribution of Uniforms

1996-97 batch Alumini organized a programme "Namma Shale, Namma Hemme" on the occasion of their batch's 25th year celebration, they distributed one pair of uniforms to 80 students of our school.

Distribution of Note books.

A doctor of our area has been distributing free good quality note books to all the students of our school for many years and this year also note books worth more than one lakh rupees where distributed to all the children.

Distribution of Scholarship.

Last year Mr.Vasudeva Acharya a student of 1964- 65 SSLC batch paid the school fees of about 72,000 rupees in the form of scholarship with the co-operation of his family members.
